Childcare rates 2023 - explained.

- The government rate for daycare is €8.97 per hour. This is the amount used to calculate the childcare allowance from the Tax Authorities.
- Additional childcare is possible, but depends on staff scheduling and the relevant legislation. This will be charged at the 40-week hourly rate.
- Daycare is provided in full-day units (7:30 - 18:30). Some locations also offer half-days. A morning half-day is from 7:30 to 13:00 and an afternoon half-day is from 13:00 to 18:30. Several locations offer early opening times or extended opening hours. Ask your customer adviser about the options.
- For the twelve weeks of school holidays, we are in line with the official school holidays for state region South. During holiday times, we may combine groups, and childcare may be provided at different locations.

Flexible childcare

Do you have a flexible work schedule? We can still offer childcare. You need to buy a fixed number of days or half-days (mornings or afternoons) per month. For day care, the minimum is four days per month.. Before the 1st of the month, you let us know when you need childcare in the following month. The hourly rate for flexible care is € 11,02.
