Supplementary childcare rates 2021.

- 1. The national standard is the standard amount used to calculate the childcare allowance of the Tax and Customs Administration.
- Daily childcare is provided in whole days (from 7.30 to 18.30) or in half-days. A morning block lasts from 7.30 to 13.00 and an afternoon block lasts from 13.00 to 18.30.
- 3. Some locations offer the option of extra childcare starting from 7.00 am for an added fee. Contact Customer Care to inquire.
- 4. With respect to the 12 school holiday weeks, we adopt the official holiday weeks as set by Rijksoverheid Regio Zuid. We also assume 2 weeks in the May holiday period.
- 5. You can request extra childcare directly through the online parents' portal.
- 6. All arrangements are exempt from VAT.
- 7. The monthly fee on your invoice may differ up to max. € 0.10 in price compared to the gross monthly fee stated in the overview of rates.
